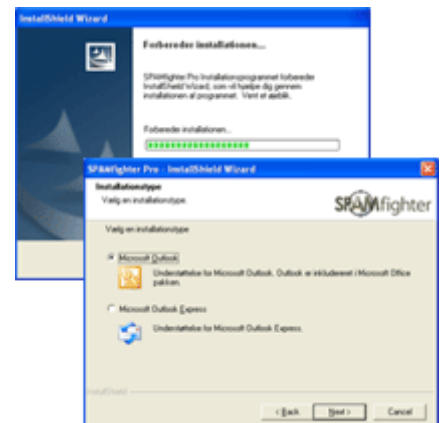
## 2) SPAMFighter is easy to install

**Note:** If you have had SPAMFighter installed by one of our ph9 technicians, then you can skip this section and jump to number 3.

Download the SPAMfighter client to your computer using the link provided in your email from ph9.

Follow the instructions on the screen and press Open or Run when prompted.

When the installation has completed, restart Outlook or Outlook Express. Now you will have the spam folder and the "Block" and "Unblock" buttons on your Outlook / Outlook Express toolbar. (Note: Your menu bar may differ from the one shown in our tutorial)



## 3) Learn how SPAMFighter works

SPAMfighter is very easy to use. You simply install it and can then just forget about it. From now on around 95% of your spam will be gone. If you want to help us continue fighting spam and help all other SPAMfighter users, you can do something to help out.

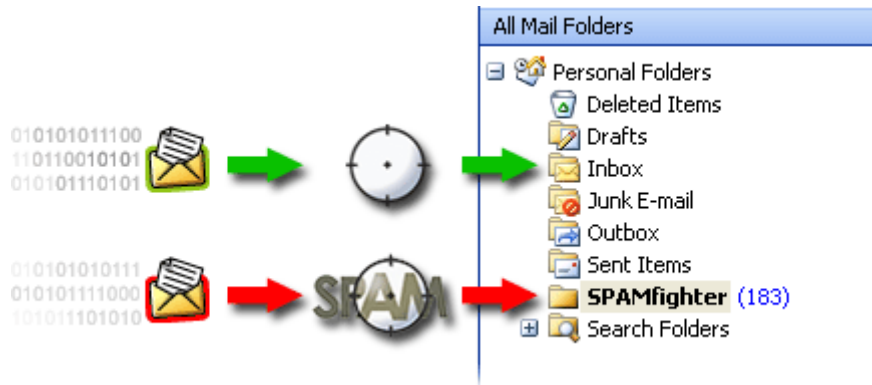
SPAMfighter exploits the power of a very large community of people that instantly report if they receive a spam mail. When someone blocks a spam mail, it is automatically filtered for the rest of the community in seconds. In this way, very few people in the community will ever see the spam mail.

On top of that, a lot of spam is filtered before it ever hits the community, but how we do that we will keep to ourselves. The spammers might be reading our site as well ;-)



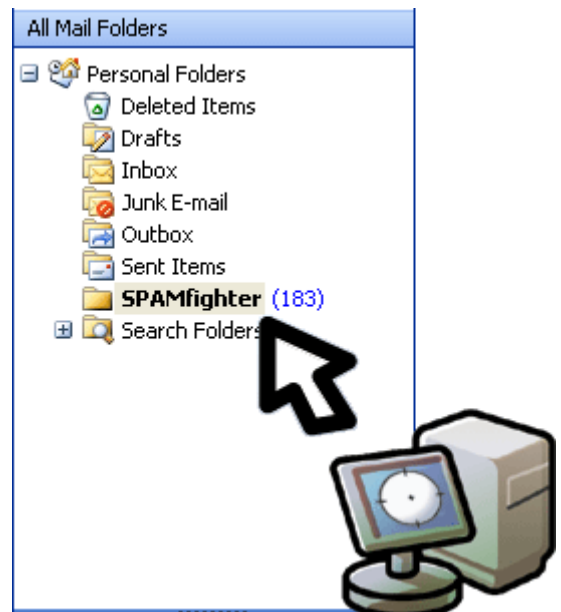
## 4) Tutorial about Auto-filtering

Each time you check your email with Outlook or Outlook Express, the system automatically checks your mail against the SPAMfighter servers list of known spam messages. If a message is identified as spam, it is automatically moved to the Spam folder.



## 5) You are in control

All Spam mails are moved automatically to the SPAMfighter folder. This process allows you to verify that all the messages in your spam folder are unwanted.

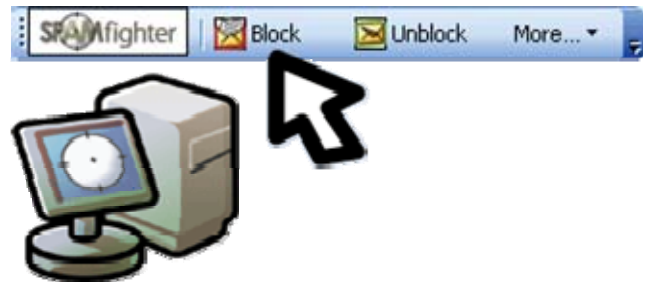


## 6) Learn how to block and report spam

Once in a while, you will receive a spam mail in your Inbox. You can contribute to the SPAMfighter community by reporting the message to the SPAMfighter server. Simply select the message and click Block in the SPAMfighter toolbar.

The spam message is then moved to your SPAMfighter folder and reported to the SPAMfighter server, instantly blocking it from all other SPAMfighter members inboxes.

The more spam you report, the more you damage the spammers and help other SPAMfighter users.



## 7) Learn how to unblock emails

Occasionally, a legitimate email may be moved to your spam folder.

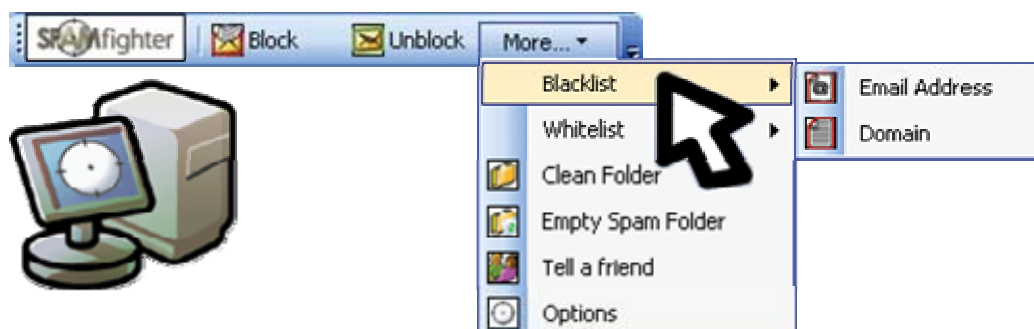
To move the email back to your inbox and remove it from the SPAMfighter server, simply select the message and click the Unblock button in the SPAMfighter toolbar.



## 8) Learn how to blacklist unwanted domains or emails

If you receive unwanted mail on a regular basis from a specific address, you can permanently Blacklist the sender. To do this, highlight the unwanted email, go to: "More" -> "Blacklist", and select "Email Address". From now on, you will not receive any further mail from this address.

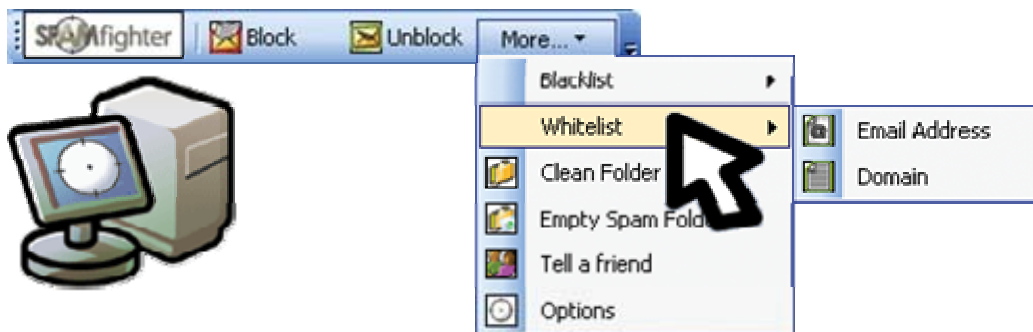
With SPAMfighter, you can also block incoming mails from specific domains. If you receive many unwanted mails from the same domain and you want to find a way to stop all emails from domains you do not like, highlight the email and go to: "More" -> "Blacklist", and select "Domain". After having done this, you can lean back and enjoy the silence.



## 9) Learn how to whitelist emails

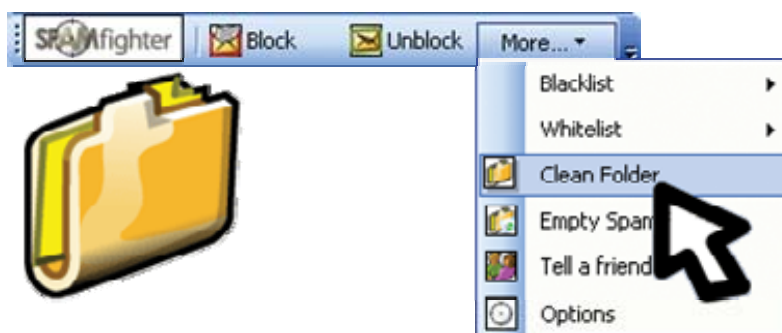
We all have different tastes. This naturally means that something you find interesting might be considered SPAM by others and thereby reported to our SPAMfighter server. You can Whitelist specific addresses quickly and easily, thereby making sure that you always receive these emails - no matter what others think of the content.

Find the email and highlight it. In the Outlook toolbar, go to: "More" -> "Whitelist" -> "Email Address". From now on, the mail will not be filtered out by SPAMfighter. You can also Whitelist everything coming from a specific domain name. Just Whitelist the Domain instead of a specific email address.



## 10) Clean your inbox for spam and empty your spam folder

When you run SPAMfighter for the first time, it would be a good idea to clean your Inbox for previous received spam. You can do this by clicking "More" -> "Clean Folder". Choose which folder to clean, and SPAMfighter will search and filter all your spam mails into the SPAMfighter folder.



If you wish to delete all the spam mails in your SPAMfighter folder then simply click on "More" -> "Empty spam folder".

Notice! If you are using "Cached Exchange Mode" you need to empty your "Deleted Items" (folder) before complete removal of your spam mails.

## 11) Language filter

If you receive spam mails in many different languages, SPAMfighter Pro users can block these incoming mails written in a specific language.

To set-up your language filter to scan for languages you don't want to receive mails in, perform the following steps:

Go to "More" -> "Options" -> "Filter settings" -> "Language recognition" and here you will be able to configure your language filter.



## 12) Learn how to update SPAMFighter

We are working hard around the clock to provide you with the best Anti-Spam software on the market. In order to stay ahead of the spammers, we will occasionally release new versions of the SPAMfighter software.

SPAMfighter automatically scans for critical updates, and will notify you when an update requires your attention.

You can also check for minor updates yourself. Go to "More" -> "Options" -> "Help" and click the "Update" button. This will scan for available updates to be installed.
